In traditional parades called Krampuslauf ("Krampus run"), young men dressed as Krampus attempt to scare the audience with their antics. The Krampus parade in Toblach is the oldest and one of the biggest worldwide. Around six hundred counterparts to St. Nicholas coming from South Tyrol, Austria, Germany, and Switzerland gather in the Pustertal valley.

## Kristmas Krampus

Everyone's heard of the jolly Father Christmas, but have you heard of his evil long-lost cousin, Krampus? He is very evil. Every 5th December, He beats naughty children with birch branches or a whip, and takes them away in his sack! But he has one weakness, if a child gives him a piece of fruit normally an apple or orange, he will have a polite conversation with the child and leave them in peace for another year. Who do you prefer? Santa or the evil Krampus. I think I already know the answer...

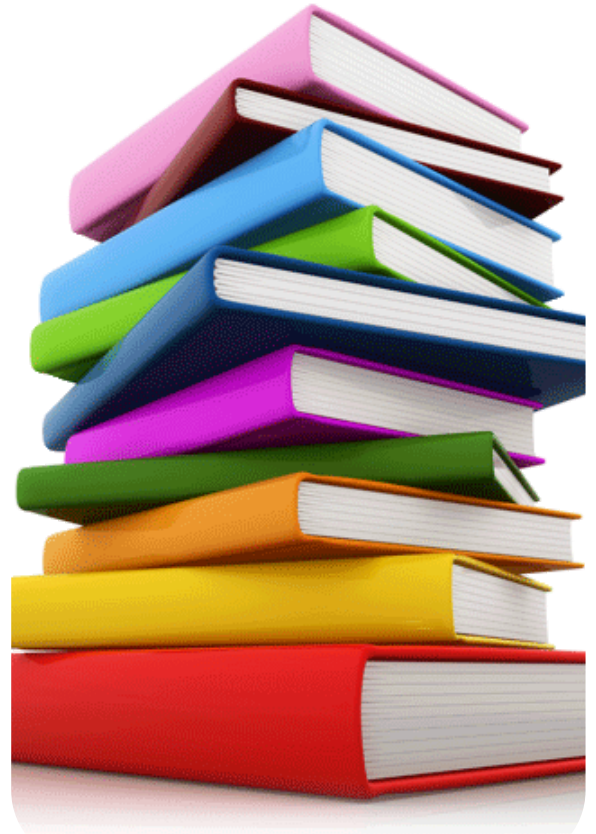

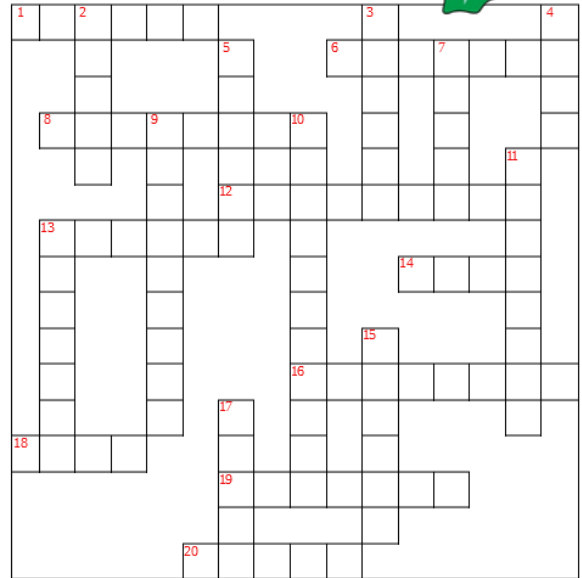
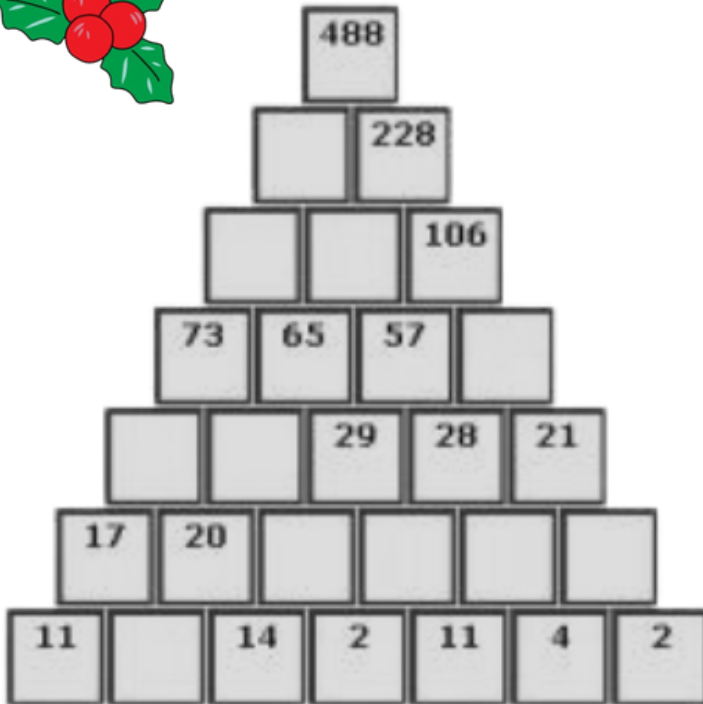
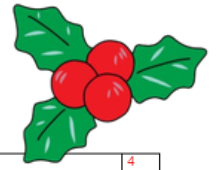
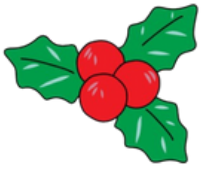


## All about Allotment Club
