

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well? A very warm welcome to the first term of the academic year. It has been a busy (and wet) week here at Sheldon and we have been delighted to welcome all our students back to school.

First, huge congratulations to our new cohort of Year 7 students, who have made such a positive start to their Sheldon journey. I have thoroughly enjoyed visiting their lessons, meeting them in their free-time and directing a number of them to their lessons as they get to grips with the room numbering. It has also been fantastic to see so many familiar faces who have joined us back in the sixth form. We have welcomed our highest number of external candidates this year from other schools across Wiltshire and BANES. So, a very warm welcome to the Sheldon family! Almost 150 students are starting their sixth form journey with us, studying a wide range of different subjects.

On Wednesday we welcomed back all students in Years 8-11 and Year 13 all moving up into their new year groups. During tutor time and assemblies, we will be outlining our school values, uniform reminders, new equipment expectations and the importance of attendance. Mr Rumble, Assistant Headteacher, who leads on attendance across the school, has already shared with you the attendance changes that came in to force this year.

Parking arrangements

Please do not park in the bus lane or along Hardenhuish Lane at any time, as this restricts access to both secondary schools.

Wet weather arrangements


