

## **5 Hours in... Business**

## **Consolidation:**

Following a business lesson, you should spend 12-15 minutes (24-30 minutes for a double) rereading your notes, researching relevant business examples, completing the Seneca for each topic and making relevant flashcards e.g., for formulas, definitions, advantages/disadvantages. You should also prepare for the next lesson by looking ahead at what we will be covering in the lesson and do some preparatory work/reading.

## **Reactive:**

This is your 'homework'. The tasks will vary but this could be exam questions or research activities from your topic booklets. You are usually given a week to complete your work. Mr Rand and Mrs Lee will be setting homework on Epraise. If you find you finish your reactive work quickly, spend more time on your proactive work.

## Proactive:

This is the section that will broaden and deepen your overall understanding of the subject you are studying. It will not necessarily involve work that has been set by your teacher, but instead it is about you doing the extra practice questions, reading articles, watching videos, etc which may contain some of the following:

- Use websites (e.g tutor2u) to complete and add to class notes (30 minutes)
- Do the work that has been set on Seneca
- Use the specification checklist and personal learning checklists to evaluate your understanding (10 mins)
- Practice exam questions from the past papers (30 mins)
- Practice writing timed essays (30 minutes)
- Watch the weekly 'Business as Usual' business news podcast and make notes on key stories (30 mins)
- Read the weekly blogs on Tutor 2U (10 Mins)
- Watch Taking the Biz YouTube clips on future topics
- Ask someone to test yourself on key topics and formulas
- Re-draft essays after feedback has been given
