Sheldon School Post 16 Results 15th August 2024

Sheldon School is delighted to share a strong set of results achieved by our A level students in 2024. These have improved on last year's outcomes and have ensured that nearly all of students were able to attend University or apprenticeship placements they had chosen. There are some outstanding results achieved by our Post 16 students with almost a quarter of all grades achieved were at A*/A and 97% of all entries achieved were at A*-E. The average grade per entry has increased from 32.3 to 33.3 grade this year, which is above the national average. These successes are a testament to the hard work and dedication of students and staff.

Overview

73% of students achieved grades A*-C, including 51% A*-B grades, which is a wonderful achievement by students, superbly supported by staff at the school. As always we are proud of all of our students achievements this year, however there have been a number of outstanding individual performances, detailed below are just some of our top performing students, but we are delighted and proud of all our students' performances.
